- 1. Each vendor is responsible for his/her own table(s), chair(s) and tent.
- 2. Each vendor is responsible for collection of their monies and payment of their own Virginia State Sales Tax.
- Each vendor agrees to set-up during the following time: beginning at 9:30 am on Saturday August 3rd and be FULLY set up and ready for customers BY 11:00 am. We ask that each vendor remain set up until 4:00 pm. Vehicles must be quickly unloaded and taken to the parking lot. Set up can take place AFTER your car has been parked. (There is a very small area to unload.)
- 4. Each vendor is responsible for his/her own goods and money. Proclaiming Grace Outreach/LifePointe Christian Church assumes no responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged goods and/or monies.
- 5. Each vendor is responsible for his/her own "take-down" at end of event. All items must be removed from premises after event is over. Proclaiming Grace Outreach/LifePointe Christian Church assumes **NO** responsibility for any items damaged during the event.
- 6. Due to limited vendor space and for the sake a variety, not all applications can be accepted. In the event that we have more than one application from a representative of a company (i.e., Scentsy, It Works, Pampered Chef, Creative Memories, Tupperware, etc.), we will accept the first application we receive for that company.
- 7. Our venue features indoor and outdoor vendor spots. These spots will be given on a first come, first serve basis (provided fee has been received). For outside spots you will need to provide your own tent for shade.
- 8. You will be contacted regarding your application after it is received.
- 9. Proclaiming Grace Outreach reserves the right to deny acceptance to any applicant.
- 10. There will be **no** refunds given for vendor applications after July 1, 2024.
- 11. All sales are between **vendor and buyer** for all/any items purchased. Proclaiming Grace Outreach/LifePointe Christian Church assumes no responsibility for any problems or issues that may occur after such sales have occurred.
